GOSPEL DISCUSSION

The woman in this story is a stranger and a foreigner and the last person one would expect to seek out Jesus. She displays great faith, more faith, in fact than the disciples ever show! And it is faith that saves her and heals her daughter.

Discuss with the children the meaning of the word 'faith'.

Share with the children some of the things in which you believe.

Encourage the children to share their beliefs.

Jesus spent time with this woman who was a foreigner and a stranger. **Who, today, would you consider a foreigner and a stranger?** Maybe they are people we have not yet met or whom we have judged to be 'different'.

It is easy to be kind and friendly to neighbours. Invite the children to think about ways they can reach out to other children who may not be their close friends. **What would be some practical and safe ways of 'reaching out' to others?**

Spend some quiet time in prayer thanking Jesus for the many ways in which he helps (and maybe heals) you!

Scam Alert - Phishing Messages and Emails

The Adelaide Archdiocese has brought to our attention that many parishioners have been receiving text messages and emails impersonating staff and or priests asking for help in the form of money or gift cards. Do not reply or click on any links and block the email or phone number. These emails and messages are designed to look legitimate from trusted sources, but they are actually attempts to steal personal information or infect your device with malware. To stay safe, it is important to remain vigilant and follow best practices for online security.

- Check the sender's email address or phone number
- Be cautious of urgent or threatening language in those messages as well as the request of sensitive information
- Avoid clicking links or downloading attachments from unknown or suspicious sources
- Verify the authenticity of any email or message that seems suspicious by contacting the sender directly
